Priorities 2024 - 2025

- **Developing a website for the Sex Addicts Recovery Podcast.**

- **Prisoner Outreach** which includes taking a meeting into San Quentin and connecting sponsors with inmates.
- **Developing an annual report** to the fellowship about Intergroup: who the officers are, what they do, where Intergroup is going and how to get involved.
